105 OFFICERS

105.1 Officers. The officers of the Authority shall consist of a chairman, and a vice chairman.

105.2 Election. The officers of the Authority shall be elected by the Authority Board.

105.3 Term. Officers of the Authority shall hold their offices for terms of three years and until their respective successors are elected or appointed and qualified, or until they resign. Vacancies occurring in any office at any time may be filled by the Authority Board.

105.4 Resignation. Any officer of the Authority may resign his or her office at any time, by written notice to the Authority Board.

105.5 Removal. Any officer of the Authority may be removed at any time by the Authority Board, with or without cause.

105.6 Chairman. The Chairman of the Authority shall preside at all meetings of the members of the Authority Board. The Chairman shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Authority. The Chairman shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Authority Board are carried into effect, and shall have the general powers of supervision and management usually vested in the office of the president of a corporation.

105.7 Vice Chairman. The Vice Chairman shall, in the absence or disability of the chairman, perform the duties and exercise the power of the Chairman. The Vice Chairman shall perform such other duties as the Authority Board may prescribe.
