Pharmacological Category: Analgesic, Nonopioid; Antiplatelet Agent; Nonsteroidal Antiinflammatory Drug (NSAID), Oral; Salicylate

Routes: PO

Indications:

- 1. Suspected cardiac chest pain
- 2. Suspected myocardial infarction

Contraindications:

1. Hypersensitivity to nonsteroidal anti-inflammatories

Dosing: CHEST PAIN/ACUTE CORONARY SYNDROME

Indication: Cardiac chest pain/acute coronary syndrome Adults administer:

 Aspirin up to 325 mg PO (chew and swallow). If no aspirin taken or suspected insufficient dose taken since the onset of chest pain, administer additional aspirin to achieve a total dose of up to 325 mg.
